RECORD PRICES FOR ILE DE FRANCE EWES

Warden 14 March 1984

An Ile de France ewe has sold for a record R5 600 at an auction held by BKB at Warden, in the Free State. The ewe was bought by Mr James Flint, of Pretoria.

A total 119 rams and ewes of Sarjoe Ile de France Stud, owned by Mr Dawie de Villiers and Dr At Viljoen, were offered for sale.

Turnover for the sale was R287 450. The 106 ewes sold averaged R2 587, a record for all breeds in South Africa.

The 13 rams sold averaged R1 011, the highest priced, bought by Mr Frankie Aveling, of Harrismith, realising R6 000.

About 250 people attended the sale.

Pretoria Show Sale Aug. 1984

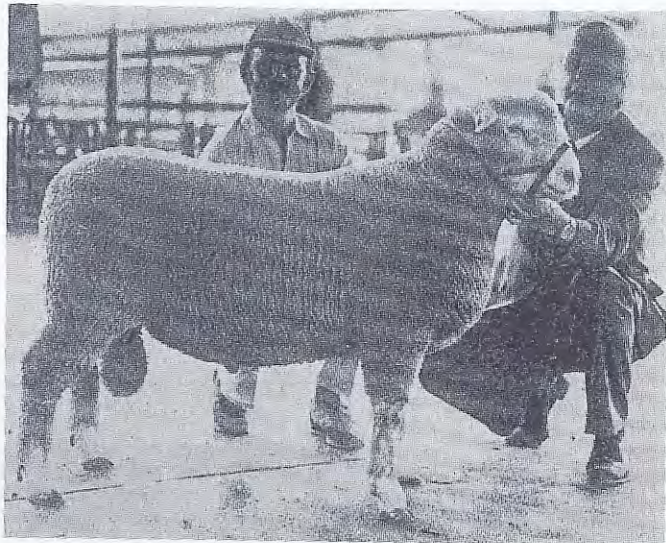
Top price at the Pretoria Show Ile de France sale was R3 000 — paid by Mr J. Coetzee, of Vereeniging for a ewe offered by Mr H.C. Franck, of Pretoria.

Mr Coetzee also paid the second-highest price — R2 900 — again for a ewe offered by Mr Franck. Of the nine ewes offered, eight were sold at an average R2 456.

Top price for rams was R1 200 — paid by Mr G. Roets, of Hammanskraal, for an animal offered by Mr H. Slabber, of Bethal. Of the 18 rams offered, seven sold at an average R571.

Turnover for the sale, conducted by Vleissentraal, was R23 650.

The South African Ile de France price record was smashed in a private sale at the Pretoria Show when the reserve junior champion ram fetched R8 000 — R2 000 more than the previous ram record.

The nine-month-old ram was sold by Mr J.I. de Wet, of Cawba Ile de France Stud, Lindley, to Mr L. Gromer, of Skeerpoort. At eight months its mass was 100 kg.

In two other private sales at show, the old record was matched when Mr James Flint, of Pretoria, sold two rams at R6 000,00 each. One went to Mr Gromer and the other to Mr A.H. Steyn, of Ventersdorp.

“Elite” ooie kudde te Universiteit van die Oranje-Vrystaat

Die kudde is in November 1983 gestig met 90 ooie, ter waarde van ongeveer R300 000, wat geleen is van 17 telers. Die doel is dat die Universiteit hul eie kudde sal vestig uit nageslag van die ‘geleende’ ooie.

Die Universiteit sal dan onafhanklike navorsing doen ten opsigte van die Ile de France wat gebruik kan word deur telers van die ras. Ramme wat geteel word in die kudde gaan terug na die skenkers en op 'n latere stadium sal ramme ook tot die beskikking van ander telers gestel word. Nadat die kudde van die Universiteit sy perk bereik het sal oortollige ooie ook tot die beskikking van telers gestel word.

Die offisiële oorhandiging van die kudde het plaasgevind op 21 Maart 1984 waartydens prof Almero de Lange 'n lesing gegee het oor Genetika vir die Stoetboer. Dr P.S. Pretorius het by die geleentheid 'n lesing gegee oor Beheer van die Voortplantingsproses by skape.

Die eerste dekking het in Desember/Januarie plaasgevind en 37 ooie het as gevolg daarvan in Mei/Junie 1984 gelam; 58 lamers is gebore (157%). Inseminasie is weer in Maart/April gedoen; 48 ooie het in Augustus/September gelam en 100 lamers is gebore (208%). Een ooi het kort voor haar lamtyd gevrek (met drieling ootjies ongebore), drie ooie word verwag om saam met die volgende groep in Januarie/Februarie 1985 te lam; en een ooi het tot so ver glad nie op hitte gekom nie.

Thus, including the ewes which arrived pregnant, three of which lambed twice during the year, 89 completed pregnancies resulted in 168 lambs born, which is an overall prolificity of 189%, and this was achieved without any hormone stimulation.

Sixty-nine ewe lambs are alive and well and 73 rams have been or will be returned to the owners of their dams.
